# Challenge to the Seven Church's

- **Laodicea** - move from Luke warmness to living wholeheartedly, passionately, enthusiastically and zealously.
- **Philadelphia** - take hold of opportunity.
- **Sardis** - spiritual reality.
- **Thyatira** - not to compromise with immorality.
- **Pergamum** - hold onto the Gospel in the face of idolatry.
- **Smyrna** - persevere in the face of extreme suffering.
- **Ephesus** - deal with the issue of lost love.

# Interesting facts about Laodicea

- Founded in the 3rd century BC.
- Steeped in Greek culture and learning.
- Laodicea lay on a very important cross-road, on the great trade route.
- Surrounded by fertile land.
- Distinctive products: garments of glossy black wool and carpets.
- Major banking and exchange centre.
- Home to a medical school famous for, a highly successful eye salve.
- Major disadvantage no permanent supply of water at hand (water brought via aqueduct from other cities)
- Laodicea deluded itself into believing it had need of nothing.

# Interesting facts about the church Laodicea

- A spirit of compromise and worldliness developed existed in the church.
- Persecution was unknown in Laodicea.
- Jesus condemns for being lukewarm.
- They were devoid of fellowship with Christ - He stands outside the church.
- In 361 AD a council was held here in Laodicea to establish the New Testament canon.

# Lessons Learned

Revelation 3 vs. 14 to 22

## **To the Church in Laodicea**

- Jesus is completely trustworthy.
- Jesus is in complete control of our lives and the circumstances that surround us.
- Jesus knows everything about us including our circumstances.
- Avoid lukewarmness like the plague.

# Jesus encouragement - to be applied in the market place
